What is Freegal?

- Freegal is a downloadable music service that is provided for your use by the Peters Township Public Library. Register to use this service at the Reference Desk on the 2nd floor with your valid library card.
- With access to the Sony Music Entertainment catalog, it offers hundreds of thousands of songs, over 100 genres of music, and more than 50 record labels, all without having to download special software.
- Each week you can log in and download 5 MP3s.
 You can stream 3 hours of music each day and also download music videos—the videos will use 2 of your weekly downloads.
- You can browse by genre or search by artist, song, album, keyword or video.
- The files are downloaded in an MP3 format, and can be played, transferred or burned onto a CD.
- When you're ready to download a track, click the download icon, select **Save** at the prompt, and designate where you want to save the song.
- Anytime you click on the download icon, even if you decide to cancel it, the download will count



towards your weekly allotment.

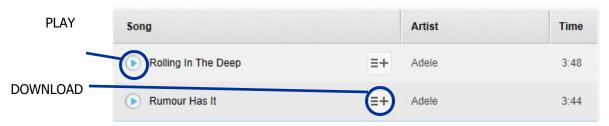

Freegal Music gives you access to over 7 million songs from over 28,000 labels included in the Sony Music Entertainment catalog.

How to get started using Freegal today!

- Bring your valid library card and email address to the Reference Desk on the 2nd floor of the library where your registration will be completed. Freegal will send a message to your email account confirming your email address and providing you with a password. You must accept the "Terms of Use" the first time you log in to be able to use Freegal.
- Go to the library's web site at ptlibrary.org, and select the eResources tab at the top of the page. Select eMusic from the drop down menu. Enter your email address and password into the boxes on the log-in screen.
- Use the browse or search options to find a song that you would like to download. You can listen to a sample by clicking on the circular "Play" button to the left of each song title.



Click the +
 and then "Download Now" to begin downloading the song to your computer.
 You are allowed a maximum of five downloads per week. There is a download usage counter on the upper right corner of freegal.com. Once downloaded, you can put the MP3 file in a music player, such as iTunes, and transfer to a MP3 player or other mobile device.

- To retrieve songs that you have downloaded within the last two weeks, click on the "Downloads" option under My Downloads on the left side of the page.
- You also have the option to download music videos. Downloading one music video will use two of your five song allotment for the week.
- The Freegal download counter resets each week on Monday at 12:01 AM (Eastern time, USA).

How to download music using the Freegal App



Download the free Freegal app to your Apple or Android-powered tablet or smartphone!

- Go to the Apple App Store or Android Google Play and search for FREGAL MUSIC.
- Once downloaded, open the app, enter zip code 15317, and select Peters Township Library.
- Login with your email and password.
- Play downloaded songs right from the app and create playlists.
- You can also stream songs or stream albums
- Songs downloaded through the Freegal app can also be downloaded to a computer (within two weeks) - simply visit the Freegal website on your computer, sign in with the same account and visit the "Downloads" under My Downloads on the left side of the web page.
