Youth Services Volunteer

- Assist in preparation for programs; help plan upcoming programs
- Organize and reshelve the library collection
- Assist patrons in locating items, requesting information, and navigating the library's electronic resources (eBooks, eMagazines, etc.)
- Test "damaged" CDs, DVDs, and Video Games
- Assist in the technical services department with processing new materials

Special Volunteer Tasks

- The library always offers large programs that need assistance. We need volunteers to help with the set up and running of these programs
- Serve on the Youth Advisory Council
 - Meets on the first Saturday of the month, 11-noon (= 1 volunteer hour)
 - Members help plan and organize teen programming and collections
