<b>Abstract:</b>	Records consist of the family photograph album of Peters Township resident Malinda May (1832-1894), elementary and Peters Township High School photographs from the 1940s and early 1950s, and assorted textual documents relating to activities at Peters Township High School.

### Biography/History

Lois Mae Houston was born in Peters Township in 1933 and lived in the township almost all of her life. Lois attended elementary school at the McMurray School and graduated from Peters Township High School in 1951. She married her high school sweetheart Ray Fosbaugh (1933-2020) in 1955 and together they had two daughters, Laurel and Carin.

### Collection Scope and Content Note

Records consist of a photograph album documenting five generations of the family of Peters Township resident Malinda May, the contents of which date from circa 1870-circa 1920. Records also include photographs of students at the Wright School, circa 1915 and at the McMurray School during the 1940s. A program from the dedication of the new Peters Township High School in 1930, a program from a 1944 honor roll service at the high school, yearbook and class photos taken at Peters Township High School between 1949 and 1952, newspaper clippings relating to PTHS graduates and the 1951 prom queen, two 1951 issues

of the PTHS student newspaper, the *Shawnee*, and a 2003 PTHS Alumni Directory of students who graduated between 1926 and 1952 are also included.

The papers are arranged in 4 series:

- Series I. Malinda May family photograph album, circa 1870-circa 1920
- Series II. Elementary school photographs, circa 1915-1940s
- Series III. Peters Township High School yearbook and class photographs, 1949-1952

### Series I. Malinda May family photograph album, circa 1870-circa 1920

**Series Extent:** 1 album

**Series Biography/History:** Malinda May (1832-1894) and her husband David May (1812-1887) were residents of Peters Township who had six children: Sarah Jane “Jennie” (born 1852), David “Alexander”, (born 1853), Samuel (born 1857), John (born 1859), Kate (born 1864), and Minnie (born 1865).

**Series Scope and Content Note:** Series consists of a large velvet-covered photograph album containing photographs of five generations of members of the Malinda and David May family dating from around 1870 until around 1920. The album includes both tintypes and paper studio cards. The majority of photographs in the album are formal studio portraits and many of the people who appear in the photographs are identified. A calling card, a greeting card and some loose photographs that were located in the back of the album are also included in the series.
