Abstract:	Records consist of documents, photographs, ephemera and clothing acquired by Toni Sulkowski while working as a teacher and, later, a principal in the Peters Township School District between 1975 and 2003.

Biography/History

Toni J. Sulkowski was born on February 26, 1953. She attended elementary school in Peters Township and graduated from Peters Township High School in 1971. Toni attended Grove City College where she earned a Bachelor of Arts (BA) in Education and Spanish.

In 1975, Toni began teaching at Peters Township School District's (PTSD) McMurray Elementary school which was located on the current site of the PTSD administration building. She taught 4th and 5th grades at McMurray, and earned her Master's in Curriculum and Supervision from the University of Denver in 1978.

Toni taught 3rd grade at Pleasant Valley Elementary School from 1980 until 1989, and at Venetia Elementary School during the 1989-1990 school year. She earned her Master's degree in Administration and Policy Analysis from Stanford University in 1988.

In 1990, Toni became principal of both Elm Grove Elementary and Venetia Elementary schools. She drove back and forth between the two schools until 1993 when the Venetia school was closed and the new McMurray Elementary School opened.

Toni oversaw the opening of the new McMurray School, serving as its principal from 1990-1993. She then oversaw the opening of the new Bower Hill Elementary School, serving as its first principal from 1999-2003. In 2003, Toni became the Director of Technology for PTSD, a position she held until her retirement in 2010.

Collection Scope and Content Note

Records consist of documents, photographs, ephemera and clothing accumulated by Toni Sulkowski while working as a teacher and, later, a principal with the Peters Township School District (PTSD) between 1975 and 2003.

Records document activities at the Venetia, Elm Grove, McMurray and Bower Hill elementary schools, including the groundbreaking, opening and dedication of the new McMurray Elementary School in 1993, and the new Bower Hill Elementary School in 1999.

Series Scope and Content Note: Series consists of material accumulated by Toni Sulkowski during her time as Venetia Elementary School's last principal from 1990 until the school's closure in 1993.

Series includes a copy of an undated pen & ink drawing of Venetia Graded School, and photographs of the school's staff and students from 1991-1992 that were removed from a scrapbook. Series also includes three spelling books from 1905 and 1929, and the Venetia School library book *Solve Suntrap: A Boy of Norway* from 1935 that includes the book's checkout record at the back of the book. (Toni removed all four books from Venetia School at the time of its closing in June 1993.) Also included in the series is a wooden spanking paddle that Toni Sulkowski found in the principal's office at Venetia School when she became principal there in 1990 and removed from the building.
