Biography/History

Walter Lushen (1896-1983) and his brother Wilbur (1907-1985) were raised on the Lushen Farm on Sugar Camp Road in Peters Township by their parents Aaron and Sarah. The brothers attended the Wright School located at the corner of Sugar Camp and Brookwood Roads and, later, Peters Township High School.

Walter and his wife Martha Jane "Jennie" Baird Lushen (1899-1999) raised their daughter Martha Mae (1928-2007) in the Lushen farmhouse on Sugar Camp Road and she attended the McMurray School and Peters Township High School.

Harriett Gillespie Baird (1902-1989) was Jennie Lushen's sister and a teacher in Peters Township.

Scope and Content Note

Records consist of photographs of school students taken at the Wright School and at Peters Township High School that include Walter Lushen or his younger brother Wilbur or Walter's daughter Martha Mae. Also included is a photograph of Jennie Baird and her students at a one-room schoolhouse in Cecil Township circa 1920, a photograph of Jennie's sister Harriett and her students at Pleasant Valley Elementary School in the 1960s, and a 1976 *Observer-Reporter* newspaper article about township educator Esther Baird and the history of Pleasant Valley School.
